Utilizing best practices, evidenced-based screening tools and curricula, MOMS has demonstrated that its program measurably improves birth outcomes and brings infants from a highly disadvantaged population to health and developmental levels that exceed those of the general population.

The purpose of MOMS is to improve the health status of mothers and babies experiencing challenges as a result of living in poverty in Orange County and to help establish a strong foundation for the baby to grow up strong, healthy and ready to learn with a community of support.

In 1992, MOMS grows out of a public-private partnership created to help solve a severe prenatal health crisis among low-income women in Orange County and starts as Maternal Outreach Management System (MOMS).

In 2008, the organization changes its name to MOMS Orange County and designs a new logo that serves us well for 16 years. It includes a tagline of "helping families have healthy babies" depicting a thriving family in traditional blue and pink colors.

In 2024, with the evolution of time and the expansion of the services we offer, our logo evolves as well. This new logo portrays the heart of our mission by featuring a healthy and happy baby symbolically surrounded by the love and support of family, friends and those in the community that are eagerly ready to help.

Regardless of name or logo, we remain steadfast in our mission of delivering bright futures by helping mothers, fathers and their families welcome thriving babies through the coordination of health, education and access to critical community services and support.

### **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS**

### MOMS IS...

### ... SPECIALTY TRAINED

The MOMS program team is highly trained to provide expanding levels of support in a number of key areas.

### **Doula Services**

Our team completed 32 hours of training provided by La Matriz Birth Services that met the DHCS requirements for training for Medi-Cal doulas and included education on childbirth preparation, lactation, and doula support. Funded by a grant from Kaiser Permanente, this training will support future efforts to expand Medi-Cal doula services to MOMS clients.

### Mental Health First Aiders

MOMS staff completed 8 hours of training provided by Providence St. Joseph Hospital in Mental Health First Aid. This training further equipped staff to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illness and substance use disorders, as well as gave them the skills to provide initial support.

### **Domestic Violence**

In January of 2024, we launched Thriving Relationships, which provides expanded support and education on the cycle of violence and connects clients to community resources including legal services. We have three case managers available to support women at risk for or experiencing domestic violence/intimate partner violence.

### **Postpartum Support**

MOMS continues to offer added support for new mothers who are struggling in the early weeks after delivery. In 2023, 103 new mothers received one-on-one visits for breastfeeding support, and 49 new mothers who were experiencing postpartum anxiety or depression received 1-4 weeks of specialized mental health home visits. Visits promote coping strategies, education and linkages to support services.



# ... MAKING STRIDES IN SUPPORTING MENTAL HEALTH

We continue to see a huge need for mental health services and thus have expanded access to our on-site therapist to two days a week. The coordination between our therapist, nurse case managers and other staff has allowed us to provide comprehensive services to clients experiencing many concurrent challenges. In the second year of UniHealth Foundation-funded programming, we provided 327 therapy sessions to 74 women, providing rapid access to licensed perinatal mental health support and a bridge to long-term therapy.

# ... PARTNERING WITH BABY2BABY

MOMS is grateful to have received a significant donation of new car seats from Baby2Baby last fall. In total, we received 1,170 car seats for distribution to MOMS families. Amazon distribution center in Buena Park generously agreed to provide space to store the multiple pallets of car seats. This opened the door to future opportunities and MOMS is thrilled to be partnering with Baby2Baby to provide diapers, wipes, baby clothes, toys, and other essentials to the families we serve.

# ... A HUMAN MILK COLLECTION SITE

During Breastfeeding Awareness Month in August 2023, in partnership with Mothers' Milk Bank of San Jose, MOMS opened Orange County's only site for women to bring their surplus breast milk to donate for medically fragile infants. Milk is collected and screened, stored for optimal nutritional value, processed, and distributed to hospitals and families. From inception through the end of 2023, MOMS collected 4775 ounces of breastmilk from 60 mothers.

### **HEALTH EDUCATION**

### My Grandparents & Me Class

MOMS recently introduced our first-ever My Grandparents & Me Class where grandparents can enjoy the enrichment and social support of a special class just for them and their grandbabies. For infants 6-12 months, this class offers intergenerational bonding, health education, a supportive community, and lots of fun activities.

### **Abriendo Puertas/Opening Doors**

This past August, with funding provided by the PNC Foundation, MOMS piloted Abriendo Puertas in English and Spanish with 47 parents participating in the 10-week series. Abriendo Puertas/Opening Doors is a culturally responsive evidence-based program that was co-created with parents and families to support parents as leaders of their families and their child's first teacher

### Pretend City Partnership

MOMS continues to strengthen its partnership with Pretend City. For the second year in a row, 15 families from MOMS are participating in a 6-month parenting workshop covering early child development, literacy, active play, and various other parenting topics. As a bonus, each family is awarded a pass to Pretend City for their commitment to learning.





### Offering First 5-Funded Prenatal Curriculum

In April, we launched a new prenatal class series offered through OC Prenatal Connect, a First 5 Orange County-funded initiative, in collaboration with Help Me Grow and Padres Unidos. "Esperando con Amor" ("Waiting with Love") is a 6-week series to reflect and prepare for pregnancy and childbirth. The series includes presentations by guest experts, including a doula and fatherhood specialist, and provides a safe space for soon-to-be-parents to ask questions and make informed decisions alongside other expectant parents.

### **FATHER'S PROGRAM**

Our father's group offerings have provided a place for dads in our community when there is such a need for these services.

### **Strong Fathers, Strong Families**

The Strong Fathers, Strong Families program continues to gather momentum within the community. MOMS hosts 6-week cohorts for fathers in-person in Spanish and via Zoom in English.

Numerous fathers have embraced the group series multiple times. Notably, one father has taken the lead in fostering connections among participants, spearheading a group chat where they share motivational messages and dad advice. Witnessing these fathers cultivate their own community is truly inspiring.


### **Becoming A Dad Workshop**

Introduced in January 2024, this monthly, one-day Becoming a Dad Workshop provides a nurturing and enjoyable environment for fathers and their babies, ages 6-12 months, to forge bonds. The workshop has swiftly become an invaluable asset to the community, facilitating meaningful connections among fathers while teaching skills in infant care and providing child development education to help manage their new roles as dads. Content also includes strategies for work-life balance as well as partner support. It is offered in alternating Spanish and English sessions.
